Aims of our course

- to build confidence and English fluency

Course Content

Skills

- public speaking (mini presentations)
- group discussion skills

Pronunciation

- knowledge of the phonemic chart including the vowel sounds of English

- intonation

What You Will Do In Class

Group Discussions: you will be guided as to what techniques will better enable you to effectively participate in a formal, group discussion e.g. interrupting politely and reaching a consensus.

Public Speaking: you will be expected to speak in front of the class on occasions to develop your confidence and fluency. This will sometimes be prepared and sometimes be spontaneous. You will also be videoed in order to assess your own performance.

Interview Skills: you will be given information about the types of questions you are likely to be asked and advice on how to answer. You will then role-play interviews, as both interviewer and interviewee. You will be given frank feedback on your performance.

What You Will Do In Class

Conversation Skills: you will learn and use relevant vocabulary, functional language and various types of questioning to improve your everyday conversational ability.

Pronunciation: you will develop the clarity of your speech through working on stress patterns, intonation, connected speech and difficult sounds.

Listening and Questioning: you will develop your ability to listen attentively and actively by interacting with others and using pre-recorded material. You will develop your ability to ask a range of questions appropriate to a range of situations.

Vocabulary: you will work on methods of building new vocabulary and using familiar language more effectively.
